Education Session

- Potential local impact of OMA/Government negotiations by Dr. Kim Spacek, AMGH President of Medical Staff
 - The process of binding arbitration between parties is presently underway
 - The Ontario government is looking to change capitation model for primary care
 - There is a significant divide between the government and the OMA
 - The Family Practice section of the OMA in rural Ontario has significant concerns about the potential government's position negatively impacting their ability to provide services in hospitals
