This past year has shown the resilience of all staff and physicians as we collectively deal with the pandemic for over two years. "You Can Count On Me" has taken on a deeper meaning as we endure the challenges and pressures from a health care system that is bursting at its seams. Yet our responsiveness during this ever-evolving pandemic has never wavered and our commitment to those in our care is never stronger. Our mission to provide high-quality, patient-centred care to our community has defined the

efforts and achievements of staff, physicians, and leaders in every program and service during these past extraordinary times.

Our Annual Report reflects the excellence of our organization in navigating challenges and changes this past year and the accomplishments we achieved together are remarkable. A big achievement this year was a formal partnership between the Alexandra Marine and General Hospital and the South Huron Hospital Association – bringing together two distinctive organizations with rich histories to deliver better care for our communities.

Many thanks to the AMGH Foundation for their continued efforts to provide funding for A utomated Dispensing Cabinets for pharmacy and a new CT Scanner which was the first of its kind to be installed in Canada.

Finally, a huge thank you to all staff, physicians, volunteers, and Board members for your perseverance, strength, and commitment to the organization. Your dedication to the hospital is unmatched and for that, I am ever grateful.

Throughout a global pandemic, the team at Alexandra Marine & General Hospital continues to live our mission of providing high quality, patient centered care to our community, delivered by a dedicated team. We would like to share just a few highlights of the great work that our team has accomplished in the past year.

- AMGH implemented HyperCare, which is new technology for our organization that includes all of
  the best features of instant messaging, which is made in compliance with Ontario's Personal
  Health Information Protection Act (PHIPA) regulations and specifically for healthcare workflows.
  HyperCare facilitates secure, seamless and timely closed-loop communication among members
  of the healthcare team and enhances patient care by allowing providers to exchange information
  about patients from the point of care and to make collaborative decisions remotely.
  - Healthcare Aggression Response Training (HART), has been implemented as an ongoing and sustainable education program, to support our staff. This valuable education includes skills in conflict avoidance, disengagement, defense of self and others, including use of restraints; advanced communication and de-escalation techniques, including support and management of patients with cognitive impairment and various mental health situations.
- Our infection Prevention and Control team, has partnered with the Ontario Health Team (OHT).
   Our OHT Infection Prevention and Control (IPAC) specialists have developed policies to provide a standard and evidence-based approach to IPAC practices regionally, resulting in a consistent

healthcare experience with a reduced risk of healthcare-associated infections. At AMGH we value this partnership and the shared expertise and resources to improve care quality.

- AMGH is partnering with several organizations in the Ontario Health Team (OHT) to participate in a first ever Joint Accreditation aimed at improving patient flow and care across the healthcare sector. Our joint accreditation journey will take place in October 2023, in partnership with other organizations in a shared accreditation experience. To bridge the gap, AMGH participated in a hospital-wide accreditation in May 2022, and successfully met the Accreditation Standards.
- There is an estimated 80,000 survivors of the residential school systems. These survivors and their families need the healthcare system to foster a climate where the unique history of indigenous peoples is recognized and respected in order to provide appropriate care and services in an equitable and safe way. Our staff members at AMGH continue to enroll and engage in learning through San'yas Indigenous Cultural Safety Program in a continued dedication on the path toward reconciliation.

To our healthcare team: skill, compassion and commitment throughout the adversities of a global pandemic is admirable. Your strength and dedication to your patients, your communities and one another has far surpassed anything imagined. Grateful and thankful does not capture just how appreciative we are to our entire health care team, within the hospital walls and beyond, for the care that they continue to provide to our patients, and for their own personal sacrifices along the way.
